✓ What is Skill Builders

Skill Builders provides comprehensive Occupational Therapy services for children birth through school age.

✓ Where is Skill Builders located?

Skill Builders is conveniently located in College Plaza, across from the Stollery Children's & University of Alberta Hospitals in Edmonton. Outreach, in home, school and community services are also available.

✓ Are Services covered by Health Insurance Plans?

YES, Occupational Therapy services are typically eligible for **Health Spending Account** coverage with many health benefits plans including Alberta Blue Cross, Alberta School Employee Benefits Plan, and Ouickcard Solutions.

✓ Does Alberta Healthcare cover your services?

NO, Occupational Therapy is covered by Alberta Healthcare through the Community Rehabilitation Program (CRP) which is administered by Regional Health Authorities. Skill Builders is not a CRP program.

Are your Therapists Registered?

YES, all of Skill Builders therapists are in good standing, registered & licensed with the Alberta Association of Registered Occupational Therapists, as well as board certified in Canada & the United States.

✓ Can you Screen for Developmental Milestones & School Readiness?

YES, Standardized screening starts at \$55.00 & includes an individualized Parent/Caregiver education session.

✓ How much is an assessment?

Clinical assessments cost \$200.00. However if a child has already been through the screening process, the assessment is completed for an additional \$80.00.

Do vou provide Treatment?

YES, Skill Builders provides individualized, family centered intervention incorporating the child's abilities & interests.

✓ Can you assist with PUF Funding?

YES, Skill Builders provides assessment, treatment & consultation services for Program Unit Funded (PUF) children.

✓ Do the parents have to pay a PUF Assessment?

NO, typically the school or agency administering the PUF grant covers the cost of the assessment.

Can families self-refer?

YES, Skill Builders accepts referrals from Physicians, educators, health professionals, caregivers & family.
